



Elections for the California Senior Legislature are coming up!

If you are passionate about issues facing older adults in California and their families, please consider running for the California Senior Legislature (CSL) representing Marin County.

People 55 or older, who are registered to vote, and who reside in Marin County (Planning and Service Area 5) are eligible to run for a seat on the CSL.

One CSL Senator and one Assemblymember are elected by the members of the Marin County Commission on Aging and hold seats on that body. Terms are four-year terms.

The Commission is an advisory council that advocates for, educates, and celebrates older adults throughout Marin County. The Commission strives to promote understanding and positive change in the community through the values of diversity, equity, inclusion, respect, and collaboration.
