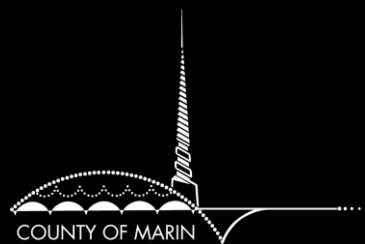

# MHSA

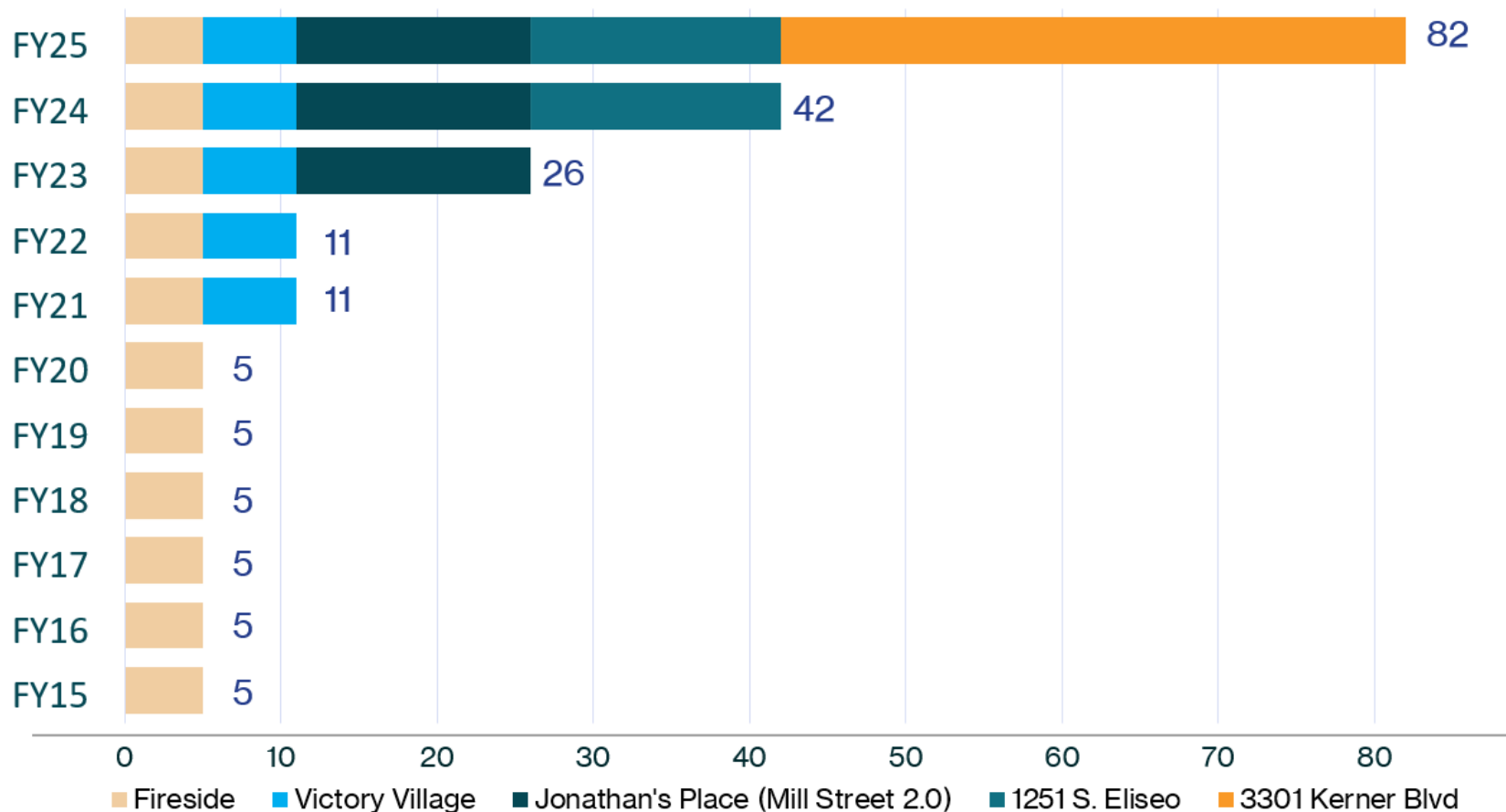
- MHSA 3-year plan approved by the Board of Supervisors today

# 3301 Kerner Groundbreaking

- 40 beds of permanent supportive housing for people with serious mental illnesses, aiming to open in late 2024
- 26 clients from Carmel Program (Homeward Bound) will move over
- 14 additional beds for BHRS clients
- Services at the Kerner clinic, on-site housing-based case management by Shelter Inc.
