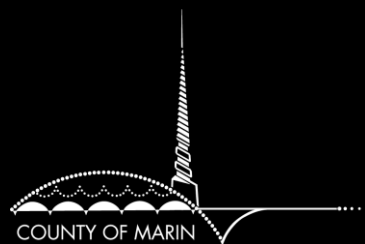

Behavioral Health Bridge Housing

Behavioral Health Bridge Housing at Arrowood – Santa Rosa

Partnership between Marin and Sonoma Counties. Marin is contracting for 20 beds (out of 71 total beds)

Temporary housing for individuals in CARE Court or other behavioral health programs. 24/7 staffing, crisis intervention, rehabilitation, case management, medication support. BHRS will continue to provide other behavioral health services, with the expectation that Marin County staff will have at least weekly meetings with clients in the facility.

Program expected to launch in January 2025.

3301 Kerner

Construction anticipated completion in January or February of 2025.

26 bed Carmel program moving to 3301 Kerner, remaining 14 beds for individuals with serious mental illnesses who are experiencing homelessness.

Prop 1 Housing and Treatment Bond

Finalizing a proposal to build a peer respite and social rehabilitation beds. Partnering with Buckelew Programs. Working on completing site acquisition, appraisal, architectural and site drawings. Applications due to the state Friday 12/13 at 4pm.

BHRS/HHS also supporting regional applications by Sonoma and Napa County, CBO applications by Ritter Center, Seneca Center, Camp Discovery, and Bi-Bett.

Homekey+

State released its Notice of Funding Availability in late November, applications open in January. \$2.145 billion in Prop 1 grant funding available for Permanent Supportive Housing. Of that, \$1.033 billion is for Veteran-serving projects and \$1.11 billion for other behavioral health-focused permanent supportive housing.

Currently completing a needs assessment by evaluating homelessness data for the prevalence of individuals who would qualify for this housing program.
