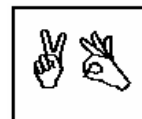

- Overall budget reduction by the same percentage
- Elimination of Tier 3 and 20% of Tier 2 (Council's reduction scenario for 15% reduction in the award).

The council will discuss and vote on a reduction strategy. Any elimination of service categories or changes to current percentage allocations will require an individual motion and vote.
