AAA Goal 1: Actively advocate for the needs of older adults at local, state, and federal level.

1a. The MCCOA Housing and Transportation Committee will advocate at the local level for affordable housing for older adults and their caregivers by attending meetings and participating in discussions in at least three towns and cities of the County of Marin.

1b. The MCCOA Housing and Transportation Committee will encourage wider attendance at committee and/or commission meetings where there are speakers on housing and transportation by promoting the meetings on social media such as Nextdoor, Facebook, and Patch.

AAA Goal 2: Pursue opportunities to improve access to information, assistance, and resources in order to achieve greater equity among older adults in Marin.
