Family Caregiver Survey Dietz explained the next Request for Proposal (RFP) Grant cycle for Family Caregivers will be issued in January.  Streets are impossible for walking, fear of falling is main concern most buildings in larkspur do not have systems equipped for hearing paired Want a senior club in the neighborhoods for the purpose of decreasing isolation Need for transportation Want Marin Village in Larkspur Want a support group, a safe place to talk about fears, family issues, feeling of isolation
