MEETING SUMMARY

Present: Ellie Bloch, Allan Bortel, Sybil Boutilier, Judy Dick, Teri Dowling, Joan Lubamersky, Madeline Kellner, Carole Mills and AAA Staff: Michele McCabe

Members reported on 68 state bills and 1 Federal Bill. Results are as follows:

- 3 bills were taken off the list because they were not about senior issues: AB 614, AB 1037, and AB 1194
- AB 1193 needed more information. Staff will review and send out to the members.
- 19 bills (see list that follows the end of this document) were recommended to be supported and need further discussion.
- Sybil recommended opposing H.R. 1578. Staff remarked that there are at least three other pieces of Federal Legislation that the Task Force should be aware of and staff will forward to them.
- Carole Mills reported that there will be a Senate Human Services committee hearing on Tuesday April 7th at 2:00 p.m. that the task force members may want to listen to. They will hold a joint hearing with the Assembly Aging and Long Term Care Committee as well as the Senate Select Committee on Aging and Long Term Care to look at long term care financing issues facing California seniors, particularly looking at middle class families who don't qualify for Medi-Cal but who can't afford long term care.
