## VIII. Unspent FY2015-16 Funds Reallocation – VOTE

- Kevin presented on budget as of December 2015. As we enter the fourth quarter, we should have spent 75% of our budget. Currently, we are on track at 76%.
- Recommendation from the County is to shift \$7,500 out of the Emergency Financial Assistance service category, and put \$4,000 into Health Insurance Premium and Cost Sharing Assistance, and the remaining \$3,500 into AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance.
- CM Kasel motioned to move \$7,500 from Emergency Financial Assistance to Health Insurance Premium and Cost Sharing Assistance (\$4,000) and AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance (\$3,500). CM Bateman seconded.

- Bylaws would need to be updated.
- Changes were proposed: Marin County Health and Human Services will have an appointed seat as a non-voting member of the council who represents HIV Prevention and/or HIV Care Services. This member will not be considered part of the quorum but will be required to attend in the same manner as Council members or the appointment will be reconsidered. Nonappointed employees may, following proper application and election, also serve as a member of the Council.
- The proposal for an appointed County seat was approved unanimously.
