**MEETING SUMMARY**

- Possible new member, Jennifer Andrade from Marin Housing was introduced and welcomed. Jennifer is a Service Coordinator for Marin Housing and an elderly/disabled self-sufficiency case manager. She will be working on several projects and will seek authorization to become a public member of this task force.
- Co-chair Bloch reported on efforts to sustain the California Senior Legislature (CSL) and Co-chair Boutilier reported on revisions to SB 477.
- The following objectives were approved for 2016-2017.
  - a. By 10/31/16, the Legislative Task Force will review and comment on the County of Marin 2017 Federal & State Legislative Programs and Legislative Policy Guides.*
  - b. By 12/31/16, the Legislative Task Force will sponsor Commission on Aging presentation regarding key policy and legislative issues for 16-17.*
  - c. By the May 2017 Commission meeting, the Legislative Task Force will recommend a formal position and advocacy regarding at least seven assembly or senate bills currently before the California Legislature during its 16-17 session.*

*d. By 6/30/17, the Legislative Task Force will recruit and retain at least two new members from the public to advocate for legislation affecting seniors and the disabled.*
