Smart Approaches to Marijuana, SAM – Mark Dale. Strength of marijuana continues to increase. Psychotic breaks are even more prevalent. WET – M. Gladstern CAMHPRO Conference starting in Sacramento. 5 people will be going, including Maya and Rashi.
