<ol> <li>Background: Measure A was passed in 2004 (½ cent sales tax). 55% of the amount goes to Marin Transit for local transit services (Develop a seamless local bus transit system that improves mobility and serves community needs including special stransit for seniors and the disabled. Of that 55%, 9% is dedicated to services for older adults and people with disabilities. The remaining is split between:         <ol> <li>Maintain and expand local bus transit service (37%)</li> <li>Maintain and expand the rural bus transit system (3%)</li> <li>Invest in bus transit facilities for a clean and efficient transit system.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>	
<ol> <li>Measure B was passed in 2010 and increased the vehicle license fee by \$10. 35% of that money is allocated to improve transit for seniors and persons with disabilities. Those funds are distributed to Marin Transit to use for mobility management programs and enhancements to the specialized transportation system (paratransit).</li> </ol>	
3. The Transportation Authority of Marin (TAM) has a Expenditure Plan Advisory Committee (EPAC) that has been meeting to oversee Measures A .They will meet on November 20, 2017 to finalize a report to the TAM Executive Committee on December 11, 2017. (Note the 12/11 meeting was canceled and has not yet been rescheduled). This report will include a strategy regarding renewing Measure A and discussing it's allocation.
