MEETING SUMMARY

- Co-chair Bloch welcomed the members present at the meeting.
- Carole Mills and the task force discussed housing in California.
- After a lengthy discussion, the group came to a consensus on the top three policy areas that they want to work on during this legislative season:
 1. Falls
 2. Memory & Cognition
 3. Economic Security (includes Health Equity)
- The next step will be discovering how to “go deeper” into those areas.
- Co-chair Boutilier spoke about the Federal Farm Bill which is increasing the work requirements for SNAP for people age 49-60.
- A change in meeting dates was debated. The group was split and decided to compromise for the rest of the calendar year. A new schedule has been made and is attached to these notes.
