6:40 PM	<p>Open Public Time: *Parent, Marion Kregelch, lost her son & is active with Residence of Marin for Health Policies *Parents, Michelle & Jeff Leopold, involved with a group for those who have lost a loved one to addiction & Anti-Cannabis campaigns</p>
6:45 PM	<p>Presentation: COVID trends of Drugs, Alcohol and Overdoses. Cat Condon presented BHRS statistics for addiction & near fatal overdoses before & during COVID. The trends pre & post Shelter-in-Place (SIP) demonstrated that drug, opioids and alcohol use rate had increased early in SIP, but eventually flattened out. The trend before stay-at-home orders was generally decreasing. Overdoses were significantly increased during the early SIP.</p> <p>Mark Dale presented RX Safe Marin & strategies for engaging people with addiction & getting to zero Opioid Overdose Deaths. Increasing Narcan access is one of the strategies. Corey Dodge discussed the delivery of Narcan everywhere- SLEs, Treatment centers, SPAR, etc. Goal is to engage nonfatal overdoses individual with treatment contact within seven days of O.D. So far Marin is more successful in outreach compared to national statistics. Closing the gap on Medi-Cal Beneficiaries and treatment contacts. But clients of color are still underserved.</p>

	Lastly, a Provider/ Practitioner Folder on Opioid Use Disorder Guide has been organized to distribute to Marin County providers.
