Puts a cap on premium increases for homeowners insurance for seniors who live in high-risk fire zones and puts a moratorium on fire insurance cancellations for seniors in high-risk zones. ○ AB 582 – Provides a tax credit for home hardening improvements for seniors living in high-risk fire zones.
