No FDA meds approved for meth & other stimulant treatment presently. • Lastly, Marin BHRS is working on a Request for Proposals (RFP) to contract with a case manager to serve clients referred from the Office of the Public Defender.

Yevette, case manager for youth & family @ MCC.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Opioid Settlements funded MCC & Ritter house programs for SUD Brianna Doyle from Ritter house is focused on coordinating services treatment, Narcan, for Ritter house clients. Don't need Medi-Cal or insurance to get services. Samantha is planning to have MCC pick up where previous programs for needles exchange have ended. Sam visits encampments, home visits to clients to engage and coordinate treatment needs. She gets hygiene kits to clients as well as Narcan. • Only up & running since the fall, they have seen 176 clients. Referrals come from MAT, self-referrals, from within MCC & Ritter House. Focused on engaging clients. • Biggest challenges: Meth SUD, connecting with Helen Vine Detox beds, & CenterPoint treatment.
