

Before Starting the Project Listings for the CoC Priority Listing

In 2024, Review & Rank panelists reviewed & determined all programs generally had high rates of housing occupancy & retention, served a priority population & were aligned to HUD & local priorities. However, one project was identified as repeatedly leaving funds undrawn from their completed grant and considered to be under-performing for this reason (per the CoC Local Competition Policies). Applicant was notified on October 10, 2024, more than 15 days before the HUD deadline.
