Background

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Marin County Public Health continues administration of COVID-19 vaccinations to eligible Marin County residents. California Department of Public Health (CDPH) allocates [Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, and Janssen COVID-19 vaccines](#) to Marin County to vaccinate residents according [U.S. Advisory Council on Immunization Practices \(ACIP\)](#) and [California Department of Public Health \(CDPH\)](#) prioritization frameworks.

Beginning March 15, healthcare providers may use their clinical judgement to vaccinate individuals age 16-64 who are deemed to be at the very highest risk for morbidity and mortality from COVID-19 as a direct result of one or more of the severe health conditions included in the CDPH [Provider Bulletin](#) (2/12/2021).

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Actions Requested of Healthcare Providers

Marin County Public Health is requesting healthcare providers identify eligible patients with severe health conditions and refer to Marin County Public Health for prioritized vaccinations.

1. Review the [Provider Bulletin](#) for updated prioritization guidance.
2. Identify and notify eligible patients with severe health conditions of prioritization for vaccination.

3. If appointments are not available, providers should advise patients to complete the Marin County [Vaccine Interest Form \(VIF\)](#). The form allows Marin County Public Health to inform eligible residents as appointments become available.
