

Smoke-Free Campus Policy: What you need to know



All Marin County owned campuses and facilities are now Smoke-Free*.

This includes all buildings that the County operates and the land around them; County vehicles; and personal vehicles on County property.

The policy covers any type of smoking, including electronic smoking devices.

The policy is to promote and protect the health, well-being and safety of all employees and visitors on Marin County campuses.

No smoking signs are posted outside buildings.

Employees who smoke need to leave the property on work breaks.
