

Marin County Guidelines for the Reporting of Tuberculosis

PPD \geq 5 mm or QFT+ AND Normal CXR AND Asymptomatic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Household or close contacts to a known active TB case* 	1 week
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Known HIV+ or at risk of being HIV+ 	1 working day
PPD \geq 5 mm or QFT+ AND CXR suggestive of TB AND/OR Symptomatic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Household or close contacts to a known active TB case* 	1 working day
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Known HIV+ or at risk of being HIV+ 	1 working day
PPD \geq 10 mm or QFT+ AND Normal CXR AND Asymptomatic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 5 years of age or under 	1 week
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clusters of individual recent converters (those with negative TB skin tests less than 2 years ago) in a school, daycare, congregate living, institutional, occupational, or hospital setting 	1 week
PPD \geq 10 mm or QFT+ AND CXR suggestive of TB AND/OR Symptomatic TB Case/Suspect (Class 3/5)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All individuals 	1 working day
Routine PPD or Quantiferon-Gold result from all other individuals is <u>NOT</u> reportable.
