MHSA and Related Updates *Kristen Gardner*

MHSA Budget: No update. Currently no concern about funding cuts in Marin in the next couple of years due to prudent planning with MHSA funds.

Client Choice and Hospital Prevention: The PEI Crisis Planning program will be implemented by CAM. The Crisis Residential program will be implemented by Buckelew.

PEI Older Adult Strategy: During the PEI planning process, it was decided to implement a home delivered meals-based program under the assumption that MMOW clients are very isolated. It turns out that MMOW clients are more connected to services than expected. Older Adult stakeholder meetings are being held to determine the best use of the funds.

Family Support Training: There will be a training June 1 from 9-Noon about Strengthening Families, an evidence based approach to increasing agency capacity to support families with a preventative, responsive, family-focused and strengths-based approach. More info will be emailed.
