MHSA and Related Updates *Kristen Gardner*

HHS Reorg: Bruce retired. Community Mental Health (CMHS) and Alcohol, Drug and Tobacco Programs (ADT) are now joined: Mental Health and Substance Use (MH/SU) Services.

PEI Program Changes

- New, short term PEI programs (*see handout*): There are unspent PEI funds that must be spent in the next few years. Some funds were allocated to increase some of the current PEI programs. Some is going to fund short-term programs in FY12-13 and 13-14. Some will be set aside to be allocated in the revised PEI planning process.

Follow-up from suggestions made in last PEI Mtg

- Connect with Southern Marin: Kristen attended a Marin City Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) meeting and will continue to attend every 2-3 months,
- MH/SU services for TAY: There is much conversation about this right now, especially with the changes in Education Related Mental Health Services/AB3632 (funds that used to go to CMHS to serve students with mental health concerns is reduced and now going to the schools).
- Upstream Prevention: Two of the short term programs (Community Coalitions and Community Health Advocates) are upstream.
- These, and more specific suggestions made, will feed into the revised PEI planning process.

PEI Trainings

- LGBTQ Trng on 3/16. A couple of agencies have not RSVPd.
- Prevention Core Competency Trngs (by Prevention Hub). Further trainings should be announced soon. If not enough are offered in FY11-12 we will not hold PEI contractors to attending 2.
