FY12-13: Additional funding has been allocated for FY12-13, with a start date of Dec 1 or Jan 1. The new PEI grantees will provide overviews of their programs at this meeting.

FY13-14: Current intention is to continue most FY12-13 allocations in FY13-14. Indication as to which funding will be continued should be available in mid-February, although final approval by the Board of Supervisors does not occur until June

MHSA 3 Year Integrated Plan: 3 Year Plan will cover FY14-15, 15-16,16-17. Groundwork for planning has begun. Community input meetings will take place in Spring/Summer/Fall 2013.

RAND Corp is offering TA to counties re: PEI evaluation. Marin is participating. Likely they will hold a regional workshop in March on Logic Models, then follow-up with a local meeting. Marin is focusing their TA on getting ready for the MHSA 3 Year Plan – such as developing a PEI logic model, and then aligning PEI programs in the 3 Year Plan and their evaluations with that logic model, including having

all PEI programs develop logic models. In the meantime, we want to support PEI programs regarding their evaluation processes for FY12-13 and 13-14.
