

## **Mobile Crisis and Triage**

### **Mobile Crisis Team:**

This team will operate from 1-9pm seven days a week all over Marin. To date we have hired: 1 supervisor; 1 Clinician; Peer providers are being contracted via Mental Health Association of San Francisco. This team will respond crisis in the community and referrals can come from Law Enforcement, Families, schools, providers, and anyone concerned about someone presenting in a crisis. This team will have the ability to place individuals on a 5150 hold if warranted. We hope to be fully staffed and functioning by mid-March.

### **Triage Team:**

This team will operate 11-7pm Monday through Friday. It will consist of 2 clinician's- 1 specializing in co-occurring disorders, 1 peer provider and 1 Family partner. These teams will support the homeless continuum of care with the intention of preventing individuals from losing their housing. The teams can provide brief case management in order to link individuals to appropriate services. We have hired one clinician to date and will be bringing on the co-occurring therapist at the end of the week. The peer provider and family partner will be contracted through Mental Health Association of San Francisco.

### **Outreach and Engagement Team:**

This team will consist of two staff; one licensed clinician and one peer provider. This team will focus on individuals not currently served by our MH system and who may be reluctant to engage in services. They will have the capacity to go out into the community and family's homes with the intent of supporting individuals to engage in services starting with a low bar in regards to engagement.
