RESOURCE ROUNDTABLE

- Catherine Condon – County Substance Use Services
 - Drug MediCal Waiver: Marin is participating in an initiative to provide a complete continuum of substance use services for MediCal recipients. Marin will see an increase in types of services. *Handouts: MediCal Waiver fact sheet, ADTP services brochure*
 - For substance use assessment and services, call County Access Line: 888-818-1115
- Jennifer Rossi – County Crisis Services
 - Crisis Continuum: Outreach and Engagement, Transition Team and Mobile Crisis. These services are fairly recent and funded by a variety of sources. There is a concerted effort for them to function as a smooth continuum. *Handouts: Crisis continuum, brochures in 3 languages*

MHSA and MHSUS UPDATES

- MHSA Innovation: The proposed Plan was posted for 30 days. Will go to Board of Supervisors and MHS Oversight and Accountability Commission (State agency that oversees PEI and INN) for approval. Plan can be viewed on Marin County MHSUS web page.
- Online Info and Referral Site: In the past PEI providers were asked to update their program info on the 211 site each year. Now there is a County site instead. marinhhs.org/community-resource-guide
- Living Wage Ordinance Declaration: For those providers who have not already signed this, Kasey will contact you to sign it. From a review of your budgets it seems you are all in compliance.

REVISED PEI REGULATIONS

We reviewed the new regs in detail. They were passed by the State in Oct 2015.

- Counties and MHSOAC will be conducting a process to address 3 areas of concern: demographics, linkage to services (tracking referral outcomes), and reporting duration of untreated mental illness. Until then counties are not implementing those aspects.
- All other areas Marin seems to be in compliance with. Kristen will be working with contractors to make sure that is reflected in PEI documents. See mid-year reports for verbiage being requested.
- We need to continue our efforts to convey all PEI outcomes accurately and effectively.
