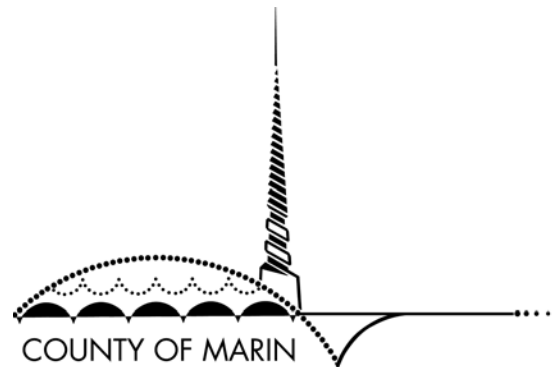

Emergency Shelters

Shelter for homeless men, women, children, and families in Marin County:

Mill Street Center:

190 Mill Street, San Rafael

Type of Shelter: 55 beds, year round night-to-night stays, must leave during the daytime hours.

How to Access: Individuals already admitted must call daily after 10:30 am to reserve a bed and can also call again at 6:10 pm to see if there are any no-shows. New callers must call at 8 am.

Fees: Contribution \$3.00 per night or \$7.00 per night if approved for a week stay.

Family Emergency Center:

737 E. Francisco Blvd., #191, San Rafael

Type of Shelter: Short-term housing for 14 families in a local motel up to six (6) months maximum stay.

How to Access: Must call to be placed on waitlist; call in each week to check on the status.

Fees: \$180 per month savings program

Center for Domestic Peace (address confidential)

Type of Shelter: Housing for victims of domestic violence.

How to Access: Call for screening interview.
